

I do not approve of the deposing of the Chief of Lac La Hache on the grounds that he was absent during the payments; he was absent earning his own living. I have discussed this matter with the Agent.

My advice to the Department is to discourage the day school as much as possible in these northern regions, as it will not pay.

I am also enclosing Dr. McFadyen's report on the trip, together with the lists of drugs asked for at the various points. As the quantities asked for were comparatively small, I have ordered these drugs from the National Drug Company here, in order that they may be shipped promptly and arrive at their destinations before winter sets in.
