I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 27th ult., inclosing a communication of Principal of the Regina Industrial School with of the cause of the fire which occurred at that inc. August 30, last, and also an estimate of the loss cause by the fire, and recommending that the Department reimburse the school for the loss of the quilts destroyed and pay the building. In reply I best by have the

building repaired in account for the loss of the quilts and blankets, but the Department, before dealing with your recommendation to reimburse the school for the loss of the quilts and blankets, would like a report from the Principal as to why the Departnent should pay this loss. It is presumed that the blankets and quilts destroyed were a reserve supply. If so, were they purchased out of the per capita grant or were they donations? The value placed upon these articles appears to be excessive.

Upon receipt of this information the Department will be in a position to give a decided answer as to whether it will be disposed to make any **prevision** contribution and to what extent.
