

Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your communication of the 15th Instant, enclosing the sum of \$234.00 balance of purchase money for Island Na:500 in the Georgian Bay, and in reply to say that attention has been called to the fact that this Island was not correctly described in the advertisement, its situation being stated as opposite the Township of Gibson, instead of the Township of Conger, and a protest has been made on this account, by a party who would have tendered for the Island, if properly described.

In view of the above, therefore, and of the fact that your tender was a conditional one, it has been decided not to carry out the Sale, and a cheque for the amount tendered by you, vis:- \$260.00 is herewith returned.
