
Ottawa, November 29th, 1918.

Madam,

Inspector Johnson in reporting on the Bear Creek School states that he recommended you to look after the books in the library. The Department trust that you will do so. If you have not already done so you should keep a book, in which each one taking a volume from the library should enter his or her name, the name of the volume taken and the date on which taken. No one should be allowed to keep any volume longer than two weeks. When a book is returned, the date should be entered.

The Inspector states that he also recommended you to pay special attention to oral composition and to devote spare time to studying the Ontario Teachers' Manuals with a view to improvement of teaching methods. The Department feels certain that you will carry out this suggestion.
