following the elections, may prove to have been equally a delusion and a snare, or for some so-called independent or third party candidate whose presence in Parliament at this very critical time is more likely to prove a source of embarrassment than a support to a government charged with the successful prosecution of the war, which until victory is achieved, must constitute our supremennational aim.
