Statement of EVIDENCE in the case of  
D-3595 Pte O, Shee J.B. No. 6 C.I.R.U. (C.R.U.)

Sir:-

At London at about 2140 hrs 10 Aug 44 I was on duty on Coventry St accompanied by L/Cpl Kilgour C.A. when I saw the a/m soldier.

He was wearing the attached Cpl's Chevrons. I approached him & requested to see his leave pass. He could not produce one. He was absent without leave. He was not in possession of M.B.M. Passes 1-2 or 3.

I placed him under close arrest & while escorting him to No. 6 (Area) Coy Detention Room he made a break and started to run & after a short chase I apprehended him again. Upon arrival at the Detention room it was ascertained that his rank was private.

He was booked into the cells to be detained.
