A I found three shacks & I found an inlet in which there were many islands about two miles in, and I went ashore there and I found a rocky ~~promontory~~ promontory - the land was very much cut up by inlets and laggons. In addition to the three houses, there was a little garden there with a fishing net around it - I would say it was about one or two yards square.

Q Were these houses occupied at the time you were there?

A No.

Q Did they show signs of anyone having lived in them?

A They are occupied every year during the fishing season.

Q Is it an important fishing place?

A Yes, one of the best.

Q How many acres do you recommend there?

A I think they should have five acres there.

Q (Examining tabulation) Now Application No. 7 - did you visit that point?

A Yes.

Q What did you find there?

A I found two tumble-down shacks.

Q Shacks that did not show evidence of being used for some time?

A Part of them were used, but the roof was in a bad condition - It was flat land covered with timber, and I see by the map it is covered by a Timber Limit. I don't think that is important, and I don't recommend it.

Q Now Application No. 8, for a fishing station - did you visit that point?

A Yes, I went ashore there and I found a rocky place by a creek, and there were two shacks there. The place is occupied every year and is used as a fishing station.

Q And they showed evidence of being occupied each fishing season?

A Yes.
