To John Chaloner, for gauging and weighing in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty, the sum of one hundred and twenty-seven pounds thirteen shillings and sixpence.

Treasurer for stationary, &c. To the Treasurer of the Province, to defray the expenses incurred by him for stationary, blanks and advertising, the sum of twenty-five pounds sixteen shillings and sixpence.
