ORDERED, That the question of concurrence be put, to morrow, upon the amendments reported from the Committee to the Bill.

A Bill for the erecting of a Toll Bridge over the River L'Assomption in the District of Montreal, opposite the village and near the Church, was, according to order, read for the second time.

On motion of Mr. Berthelot, seconded by Mr. Mure,

RESOLVED, That the faid Bill be referred to a Committee of five Members, with power to fend for persons and papers.

ORDERED, That Mr. Berthelot Mr. Roy Portelance, Mr. Planté, Mr. Richardson and Mr. Mure, do compose the said Committee.

And then, on motion of Mr. Mure, seconded by Mr. Roy Portelance,

The House Adjourned.
