## Acts already passed, or that may be passed, in future, noting the periods at which they will feverally expire.

Mr. Blanchet, from the Committee to whom was referred, the petition of *Jacques Morin*, of the County of *Hertford*, reported, that the Committee had examined the matter of the laid petition, and had directed him to report their opinion thereon to the Houle, and he read the report in his place, and afterwards delivered the fame, in at the Clerk's table, where it was again read;

## The faid report is as followeth :

The Committee after having confidered the petition of Jacques Morin, is of opinion, that the faid petition and conclusions of the fame, ought to be granted; but fhould any one offer to build a bridge over the River du Sud, the Committee confiders that the perion to offering, ought to have the preference to build also the one over the arm of the faid River du Sud.

Mr. Blanchet moved, feconded by Mr. Taschereau, that the Committee to whom is referred the petition of *thomas Alexis Gosfelin*, of the County of Hertford, have power to fend for perfons and papers.

Mr. Mure moved in amendment, feconded by Mr. Borgia, to ftrike out all the words after "that," and infert "the report of the Com-"mittee on the petition of Jacques Morin, be re-committed to the fame "Special Committee, for further confideration."

The House divided on the question of amendment.
