Sorel, Sept. 29.—Last night about seven o'clock, a train coming from Yamaska, ran over an obstruction which had been malicicusly placed across the track. Six platforms were in front with about seventy-five labourers on them. The engine was in the rear and was running at a fair speed when the accident occurred about two miles from Yamaska. A man placed in front of the train with a light made signals when he saw there was danger and jumped overboard, as well as all the men on the same platform car. Conductor Swan stopped the engines, and every one on the tender with him jumped out without any injury. Two or three platform cars were upset by the shock, and all the men on them were crushed under their fearful weight. The number killed is eleven, and twenty-five were awfully bruised.
