Europe

London, April 3.—The Paris Commune issued a decree arranging their, Picoté, Dufur, Simon, and Picholov be the Tribunal of the People and order their property to be seized. The decree further pronounces a separation between Church and State, suppresses religious bodies and abolishes national property.

Germany

Berlin, April 2.—In the Reichstag yesterday a bill for the government of Alsace and Lorraine as part of the German Empire was read and referred to a special committee. The bill moved that the Polish territory be included. Mottet rose and explained the policy of the Government towards France.

France

Paris, April 2.—The Paris Journal d'Alsace reports a collision on the bridge between the Communards and the regular troops. The Communards were on the alert last night, fearing an attack. They were, however, not molested in the Bois de Boulogne and a large number in the Bois de Vincennes. The gates of Malto, Auteuil and Fontaine-au-Loup have been closed.

He expressed his opinion that the Northern Pacific Company, who would have nearly 10 million of stock to run through, would never be able to pay the interest on the loan. He stated that the Government was determined to push the road to the Pacific coast on their own terms.
