Superintendent T. J. Brown has issued a special order to all the colliery managers asking them to adhere to the following rule in the Mines Regulation Act, Section 21:- "No boy of or above the age of twelve years, and under the age of sixteen years, shall be permitted to work in or about any mine below or above ground, unless he furnishes a certificate from the principal teacher of the schools, or school of the section, of having satisfactorile completed the prescribed course of study up to the end of Grade VII.

This is the saving boys clause of the Mines Regulation Act, and it is earnestly hoped that the colliery officials will recognize the law and keep the bright lights of this country out of the depths of the dark dirty earth. What a shame to see a father leading by the hand a tender youth of twelve years to the manager's office seeking employment for his son, and thus sacrificing his hopes and forever blasting his ambitions. No parent is so poor that he cannot afford to educate his son up to his sixteenth year.
