BREWSTER & LYON, of New York, have be-  
gun the manufacture of fulminate of mercury  
at Prescott. They brought in 700 barrels of  
alcohol, a carload of quicksilver from San  
Francisco, and 850 carboys nitric acid, all of  
which they will use in about six weeks in  
making fulminate, which latter is utilized in  
the manufacture of dynamite caps.

THERE was launched last month from the  
shipyard of Messrs. Connell & Co., near Glas-  
gow, the steel screw steamer "Gulnare," built  
to the order of Alex. McLeod, of Prince  
Edward Island. This smart little vessel, says  
the *North British Daily Mail*, is intended as a  
surveying steamer and is chartered by the  
British Government for the Admiralty survey  
of the Canadian maritime coasts. She was  
to leave Glasgow about 20th April:

A SOMEWHAT important country failure is  
that of E. Gohier & Co., general dealers, St.  
Laurent, near Montreal. They have been  
notoriously slow pay for several years past,  
but have always claimed a very large surplus.  
This, however, is largely based upon inflated  
values put upon large real estate holdings,  
bought for speculative purposes. The liabili-  
ties of the firm are said to reach about \$60,000,  
and are largely in the shape of mortgages.
