To not teep end to Recalling also General Assembly resolution


Considering that the Commission on Human Rights had been unable due to lack of time to prepare such as nevel execommendations at its ninth session,

Considering the importance of the observance and respect for the right of self-determination in the promotion of world peace and of friendly relations between peoples and nations,

- to give due priority to the preparation of such recommendations at its tenth session,
- to the Commission on Human Rights the summary records of the debate on the matter."
