Market Situation and Outlook

- 1989 was a terrible year for Canadian frozen roe exporters due to high carry over inventories in 1988 and reduced demand.
- Low inventories at the end of 1989 have led to a strong demand situation for 1990.
- The Canadian supply is estimated to be 8,000 MT's in 1990.
