

Supporting the UN - Canada's Role



The strongest support exists for the contribution of Canadian troops for a standing UN peacekeeping force (70% agree), lending the UN people for "military and policy advice" (68%) and for the creation of a Canadian unit designed for rapid deployment on UN missions (67%). Indeed, these options seem equally appealing to the Canadian public. Less support exists for the contribution of equipment to UN missions (57%). Finally, there is little support for giving the UN money (36%).

Striking regional differences exist regarding support for Canada's UN options, as depicted in Figure 20. As Table 6 shows, Atlantic Canadians show the greatest enthusiasm for all the options tested, while Quebeckers are uniformly less supportive.
