## BEATTY NAMES NEW SPOKESPERSON

External Affairs Minister Perrin Beatty today announced the appointment of Bob Peck as his Press Secretary and Spokesperson, effective July 21, 1993. Mr. Peck replaces Scott Mullin, who has been posted to the Commission for Canada in Hong Kong.

Mr. Peck, a native of Pointe Claire, Quebec, and a graduate of Concordia University in Montreal, joined External Affairs and International Trade Canada in 1982 and has served in Lagos, Nigeria, and Berne, Switzerland. Since his return to Canada in 1987, Mr. Peck has worked in the department's Corporate Management Division; the Media Relations Office and the Consular Policy Division. For the past year, Mr. Peck has been a Foreign Service Officer with the International Service of Employment and Immigration Canada.
