*Mr. MacLean*—On Saturday next—INQUIRY OF MINISTRY—1. Is it the intention of the Government to link up the various provinces of the Dominion with a national highway?

2. If so, will a permanent highway be built through Prince Edward Island as part of this scheme, connecting with the car ferry steamer at Borden?

3. If the said highway is built, will the entire expense be paid by the Federal Government or will the province be called upon to pay a certain per cent of the cost?

4. Apart from the national highway, is it the intention of the Government to grant aid to each province for highway construction and in what proportion?

*Mr. Parent*—On Saturday next—INQUIRY OF MINISTRY—Is it the intention of the Government to expend any of the \$20,000,000 voted by Parliament to relieve unemployment, for the construction of an extension of the protection wharf on the north shore of the river Jesus des Milles-Iles, in the city of Terrebonne?

2. On what date did he resign as Speaker of the House of Commons?

4. During the same period, were his servants in receipt of salary? If so, what amount was paid to each?
