

January, the second Monday in April, the second Monday in July, and the second Monday in October.

2. Special Meetings shall be called by the order of the President upon a requisition in writing, signed by five members of the Society, stating the object of the proposed meeting.

3. Upon receipt of such requisition, the President shall instruct the Recording Secretary to summon a Special Meeting by giving at least three days' notice thereof to each member, stating the object for which it is summoned. No business shall be transacted at a Special Meeting other than that for which it is called. Such notice may be given by the Secretary by mail or otherwise, and said three days shall begin to run, in cases of notice by mail, from the time when said notices are posted. For the purpose of said notices, the address of each member shall be considered to be that given by him to the Secretary.
