

tution and the Act of Incorporation. They shall fill vacancies in their own number caused by death, removal from the province, resignation or any other cause, or among the officers of the society, and may declare the place of any member of the Council vacant who shall be absent from more than three successive meetings of the Council without sending a reasonable excuse therefor to the society.

ARTICLE VI.—OFFICERS.

The officers of the society who shall also be members of the Executive Council shall be as follows:

President,
1st Vice-President,
2nd Vice-President,
Corresponding Secretary,
Recording Secretary,
Treasurer.

The above officers shall be elected by ballot at the annual meeting of the society, and shall serve for the term of one year and until their successors are appointed.

If any officer is absent from the monthly meetings of the Executive Council more than three successive meetings, unless detained by sickness, absence from the Province, or any just cause, his office may be declared vacant.

ARTICLE VII.—VACANCIES.

If a vacancy shall happen in any of the offices of the society or in the Executive Council it shall be filled by a special election at the next meeting of the Executive Council, and the person so elected shall hold his office for the unexpired term of the person vacating the same.
