President, one of the Vice-Presidents strall exercise the sume authority.
XX. That the Treasurer shall take charge of aht monies put into his hands, belonging to the Society ; keep regular accoments thereof; honor all the orders of the Society signed by the President, (to the extent of the funds in his hands and no more), and he shall lay before the members at each quarterly meeting, an abstract of his receipts and disbursements for the preceding quarter.
XXI. That the Secretary shall keep a fait register of all the Proceedings, Orders, Rules or Regulations of the Society, and shall cause the same to be entered in a suitable book or books, provided for that purpose; he shall summon the Society to the Quarterly and Annual Meetings, and give notice on any other occasion on which he may be directed so to do by the President, or in his absence, either of the Vice=Presidents; he shall also sign oll drafts ordered by the Conumittee; ambstiall lay before each Annual Meeting a Report of the Transaetions of the Society for the present year.
XXII. That the Stewards shall make all the necessary arrangements for the Anniversary Dinner, with the assistance of the President, Vice-Presidents, Secretary, and Treasurer.
XXIII. That it shall be the duty of the Committee of Accounts to audit the Books of the Treasurer, and to confer with him respecting delinquents.
XXIV. That the members of this Society shall faithfully observe and conform to all the Rules and Regulations that shall be made by the Society, and entered into the Books thereof, on pain of being dismissed from it, and having their names crased from the list of members.
XXV. That these Rules and Regulations shall be altered or amended at general meetings only, and no motion of an alteration or amendment shall be received, unless notice of the same shall have been given at a previous quarterly meeting.
