SEC. 2. Special meetings of the Executive Committee shall be called by the Secretary, either at the written request of three members of said Committee, or by written order of the President, and notice of said meeting shall be sent to every member of the Executive Committee ten days prior to said date.

SEC. 3. At every meeting of the Executive Committee, the place for holding the next meeting shall be decided upon prior to adjournment and in the event of a special meeting being called it shall be held at the place chosen for the next meeting, or at such other place as may be agreed upon.

SEC. 4. At all meetings of the Executive Committee a majority of members shall constitute a quorum.

SEC. 5. The Executive Committee may at any meeting, by a majority vote, reconsider the decision of the Status Committee as to the amateur standing of any oarsman, and by such vote repeal the action of the Status Committee. The decision of the National Association of Amateur Oarsmen on cases
