βασανιστῆς (basanistēs).

- Matt. xviii. 34. Delivered him to the *tormentors*.

κόλασις (kolasis).

- Matt. xxv. 46. Into everlasting *punishment*.
 1 John iv. 18. Because fear hath *torment*.

ὀδυνάομαι (odunaomai).

- Luke ii. 48. I have sought thee *sorrowing*.
 „ xvi. 24. For I *am tormented* in this flame.
 „ xvi. 25. And thou *art tormented*.
 Acts xx. 38. *Sorrowing* most of all for the words.

κακουχούμενος (kakoukoumenos).

- Heb. xi. 37. Being destitute, afflicted, *tormented*.
 „ xiii. 3. Them which suffer *adversity*.

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
