THE GRAND COUNCIL.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS.

1. The officers of the Grand Council shall be elected by ballot, and hold their offices for one year or until their successors shall have been regularly elected and installed.

THREE SCRUTINEERS.

2. The presiding officer at the annual meeting shall appoint three Scrutineers, whose duty it shall be to count the ballots for Grand Officers after they have been collected by the proper officers. The Scrutineers shall solemnly pledge themselves to make a correct report under their hands of the result of the ballot; and having ascertained the number of votes for the respective candidates, they shall present their reports to the Grand Council.

3. The election of all officers of the Grand Council shall take place at the annual meeting, immediately after the call of the order of "New Business"; and as soon as the election shall have been completed, the officers so elected shall be duly installed by some duly authorized officer.
