nors, has limited the remarks we have to offer, and to a certain extent cramped our enquiry.*

The number of bound volumes unaccounted for amounting to nearly seven hundred [674],‡ may be interpreted as reflecting on all Governors, officers and graduates who have had access to the literary under Statute, Cap. VI, Sec. 2, as well as upon all students and persons who have had access to the Library by permission, whether duly authorized or otherwise.

The irregularities of which we complain extend more or less over a period of sixteen years, and notably over the last six years, as shown by the unexplained list in detail, deduced

Howover, on the subsequent appointment by the Board of Governors of a new Librarian, and on this official calling in all books belonging to the Library, over three hundred (300) volumes were returned, of which only a small proportion was registered as lent out.
