IMPERIAL LOAN AND INVESTMENT COMPANY

The thirty-fifth annual meeting of the shareholders of the Imperial Loan and Investment Co. was held yesterday at the office of the president, Mr. John H. Tilden of Hamilton in the chair. The report of the directors shows that the company has during the past year received \$8,000,000, out of which the cost of management and dividends were paid. The general meeting, namely, \$10,000,000, the balance of \$2,000,000, was carried over to the next year.

PASSING OF STEPHEN

With the passing of Sir Leslie Stephen, K.C.B., president of the Ethical Society, who died yesterday, England loses one of her most distinguished men of letters. He was born at Kensington Gore, London, on Nov. 28, 1834, and was educated at Eton, King's College, London, and Trinity Hall, Cambridge, where he graduated B.A. in 1854 and M.A. in 1857. His first wife was Harriet Martineau, a philosopher and social reformer.

A CREEL PRACTICE

Many humane societies in Canada have interested themselves in the suppression of the cruel custom of docking horses' tails. Some of them have placed on record resolutions strongly deprecating this form of brutality. Canadian sentiment is still far behind public opinion in the United States, which in some instances has forced the legislature to take action. The revised laws of the State of Massachusetts contain a section which prohibits the mutilation of horses. Here is the section:

Sec. 72: Whoever cuts the bone of the tail of a horse for the purpose of docking the tail, or whoever causes or permits the same to be done upon the premises of which he is the proprietor or in his presence, or whoever assists in or procures, or causes to be procured, such cutting, shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than one year, or by a fine not more than one hundred nor more than three hundred dollars. If a horse is so found with its tail so cut and with a resulting wound from such cutting, the person so found guilty of any person or in the presence of any person, such fact shall be prima facie evidence of a violation of the provisions of this section by the owner or user of such horse, or the person having such charge or custody, respectively.

THE SINEWS OF WAR

The financial position of Russia is compared with that of Japan by The Philadelphia Inquirer. The national debt of Russia is the second largest in the world, \$3,200,000,000, exclusive of railroad bonds guaranteed by the government, and other obligations aggregating \$500,000,000. The deficit last year was \$300,000,000 on an income of \$800,000,000. The Trans-Siberian railroad is said to involve an annual loss of \$20,000,000.

ELECTRICITY STEAM RAILROADS

The Railroad Gazette points out that on a large scale passengers can be hauled for 30 per cent. less by electric power than by steam, disregarding fixed charges. The cost of the change from steam to electricity, however, is simply appalling. "For long distance heavy freight trains the time for using electric motors is farthest on, and without further and unexpected developments the time for changing the power on existing freight tracks may never come. For suburban passenger trains and spur lines it is impracticable for longer distance passenger trains it is not at all improbable. GO TO LEGISLATURE FOR ELECTION SAFEGUARDS

City Council Pass on Two Motions—Make Interim Investigation Grant of \$1000.

The chief subject under discussion at the meeting of the city council yesterday was the best method of providing against irregularities in municipal elections. A number of the aldermen had suggestions, which they considered would improve the system to use, but others wished no action taken until the civic investigation showed how widespread the irregularities had been. It was finally decided, however, that the city solicitor should endeavor to obtain legislation from the local house to give the city more control over the elections.

A motion was introduced by Controller Spence and Hubbard providing that the police commissioners should be requested to have the chief of police station a constable at each polling place in municipal elections to assist in maintaining order, to watch the counting of the ballots and to take charge of the boxes after the closing of the polls.

Ald. Ramsden said he would facilitate anything that would protect the ballot box, but the motion was an indignation that the police were required to watch the boxes. He did not believe that the deputy returning officers were crooked in many cases, and considered that there was no necessity for haste.

Controller Spence said he did not want the policemen to watch the deputy returning officers, but to obstruct outside pluggers.

Ald. Costworth and Crane moved that the legal department be instructed at once to apply to the legislature for an act giving the city council authority to take such steps at any municipal election either by way of placing an additional officer in each polling booth or by providing for a special scrutiny of ballots immediately after such election otherwise, as may appear requisite to secure a fair, honest and pure election.

Both of the motions were carried. On consideration of the recommendation of \$1000 to be paid for clerical assistance in connection with the civic investigation, Ald. Costworth said the impression was widespread that the results of the enquiry were not satisfactory to justify the expenditure. He wished to know to whom the \$1000 was to be paid. The mayor explained that the money was going to pay for making copies of the poll books and to the policeman who canvassed the divisions.

He said that the \$1000 would cover the whole city, but this estimate was considered very small. The mayor stated in regard to the amount of counsel fees to be paid, and he could not say what the cost would be, but the bills could be taxed. The item passed unanimously.

The Metropolitan Terminal. Regarding the removal of the terminals of the Metropolitan Railway from Yonge-street, the company have been unable to obtain their title to the property. The company expect to secure the required property this week, and will then proceed to carry out the agreement with the city. A letter was later handed in from County Crown Attorney Drayton, in which he asked if the ordinance had been abated, and notified the aldermen that the case would come up at the March session.

Dr. Harrison introduced his bill to prevent expropriation in public places, but Ald. Chisholm, in the chair, stated that the legislation committee had not yet considered the matter. Ald. Harrison, however, turned up the records and found that the legislation committee had approved the bill, as well as the board of control, and it had been endorsed by council. The bill was found to be loosely drawn, however, and was sent back.

Controller Hubbard presented a petition from Messrs. Donoh and Verrill, livery owners, and also from a number of cab drivers, protesting against the establishment of a cab stand in front of the King Edward Hotel. The police commissioners will deal with it.

Revised Assessment Roll. The city clerk handed in the finally revised assessment roll for 1904, showing a total value of property assessed at the city as \$142,285,522. The Court of Revision added \$1,402,130 and deducted \$2,475,000, while the city judge struck off \$101,904 and made increases amounting to \$31,200.

Ald. Graham's motion that the street cars operating upon Arthur-street should be continued westward along Dundas-street to the car stables, and that the city engineer be requested to report upon the matter, was carried.

The bylaw providing for the sale of debentures to the amount of one million dollars for improving the waterworks system was given its second reading. It will be advertised and sent on to the electors for their approval before being finally passed.

Ald. Costworth made enquiries regarding the temporary quarters to be provided for the Berkeley-street firemen, saying that one man had been instructed to leave the hall and others would follow. He was assured that the controllers had taken action in the matter.

Wanted His Lot Back. Chas. Swabey asked that he be allowed to redeem a lot at the corner of Danforth and Broadway, which he had sold to the city on payment of arrears of taxes and interest. The board of control had recommended that the property be sold to St. Barnabas Church for \$141,666, and the back taxes amounted to but \$110. Ald. Costworth moved that Mr. Swabey be allowed to redeem, but the mayor pointed out that the former owner had done nothing since 1892 in the matter and had only made a claim after the city had found a purchaser. Ald. Costworth withdrew his motion in view of the strong opposition to it.

That Cattle Market Embroiled. On motion of Ald. Chisholm it was resolved that the city solicitor should apply for legislation permitting the city to sell feed at the cattle market. Ald. Dunn again raised the objection to the method of settlement adopted by the property commissioner in dealing with the lessee of the feed at the cattle market. He moved to refer back the report, and also that the commissioner be instructed to close up the business of the market for the year advised by the treasurer. Ald. Jones, lessee of the privileges at the market, was indebted to the city in the sum of almost \$8000. Controller Spence threw the blame for the condition of affairs on the property committee of 1903, and said the trouble had largely been caused thru the action of certain members of the council who had not been loyal to the city as they should have been. Ald. Jones upheld Ald. Dunn's position, saying the market business should be cleared up from year to year. On vote being taken, however, he was found to be Ald. Dunn's only supporter.

Ald. Jones disclaimed any connection with the resolution providing for the purchase of the Ferry Co's plant, which had been ascribed to him by the press. While he favored the proposition he believed the credit for the motion was due to Ald. Sheppard.
