PRaise CHINESE CREW FOR RESCUE

Steamer Strikes Rock Near Shanghai; 25 Drown When Lifeboat Upsets

SHANGHAI, Dec. 13.—With all foreigners aboard the steamer Lien Shing, which sank yesterday after striking Ahuwei Rocks, 64 miles out of here, accounted for and bodies of eight of the 180 Chinese passengers recovered, search was continued today for more than 30 native passengers reported missing. Twenty-five Chinese drowned when a lifeboat upset. Mrs. Cora Sutton Castle, authoress, wife of a San Francisco surgeon, was among the passengers rescued.

Passengers, who have been brought here, paid a high tribute to the officers of the Lien Shing, and the Chinese crew for their gallantry and courage in the emergency.

Convict Weds As Jail Term Starts

WILTON, Ont., Dec. 13.—Bert D'Angelo, the 32-year-old Hamilton fruit peddler, who on November 20, was sentenced to four years in Portmouth penitentiary on a charge of manslaughter in connection with the death from poison alcohol of William Mappee, was married to Miss Janet Blair Goodie, a 26-year-old Scottish girl of Toronto, on Saturday. The ceremony was solemnized in Sheriff Webster's office in the court house by Rev. Canon L. R. J. Nafed, rector of Grace Anglican church, Milton. After the ceremony, D'Angelo was taken back to his cell and his wife returned to Toronto.

Wants All Cabarets In Rome Closed Up

ROME, Dec. 13.—Permanent padlocking of all cabarets, night clubs and dance halls in Italy, is demanded by the semi-official newspaper Popolo Roma, commenting on the fire Friday night in the Apollo Music Hall, in which four women lost their lives. Theatres and movie houses, says the paper, should be allowed to function only when guaranteeing absolute safety, but cabarets and night clubs should be closed permanently, because it contends, "the only purposes they serve are facilitation of drunkenness, the use of drugs, propagation of disease, encouragement of idleness, the wasting of money and the corruption of youth."

Motion To Abolish Cabinet By-Elections

OTTAWA, Dec. 13.—The expected move to abolish the practice of re-electing members of parliament who accept cabinet positions has been made by S. W. Jacobs, (Lib. George-Etienne Cartier). Mr. Jacobs has given notice that he will bring in a bill "to remove the necessity of the re-election of members of the House of Commons of Canada, on acceptance of office." It will be private members' bill.
