- Q.35 Now, may I interrupt just once more. When as you say you attended on Captain Jessop, the conversation you have just quoted, is that the full extent of it?
- A.35 Would you repeat that sir?
- Q.36 When you were with Captain Jessop, were you alone?
- A.36 No sir, Corporal De Bartok was with me.
- Q.37 And have you given the full extent of the conversation? In other words, have you quoted the conversation to its fullest extent?
- A.37 No, Captain Jessop mentioned something about we should have got more for the tires.
- Q.38 All right, carry on.
- A.38 So at this time Captain Jessop again signed my work ticket and I returned to B squadron. Corporal De Bartok was present when the work ticket was signed.
- Q.39 Now, I would like to ask you a couple of questions, Corporal Tengum. Did you have a work ticket to proceed to Gronigen in company with Corporal De Bartok?
- A.39 Yes sir.
- Q.40 Was this work ticket duly signed?
- A.40 I don't get what you mean sir.
- Q.41 Was the work ticket signed?
- A.41 Yes sir.
- Q.42 Who was it signed by?
- A.42 Captain Jessop, sir.
- Q.43 Who made out the work ticket?
- A.43 Corporal De Bartok sir.
- Q.44 Who received the work ticket?
- A.44 Corporal De Bartok.
- Q.45 From whom did he receive it?
- A.45 Captain Jessop, sir.

Def Offr: How can he say all that when he wasn't present, now I ask you?

The Prosecutor continues with the examination of the witness:

- Q.46 Did the work ticket bear any other authorization except the authorization of an ordinary work ticket?
- A.46 No sir.
- Q.47 All right, continue.
- A.47 That afternoon I left for Gronigen again with this jeep. When we got to Gronigen I delivered De Bartok to his girl friends house and I returned to Jan Hoffstie's house.
- Q.48 Well now, just a moment. I'll interrupt again. You have already told the Court that you proceeded down to Gronigen accompanied by Corporal De Bartok, affected the sale of four tires, returned in company with De Bartok, attended on Captain Jessop, paid the monies over to Captain Jessop. I think that's all we require.

The witness is cross-examined by the Defending Officer:

- Q.48 Corporal Tengum, you have given a lot of evidence just recently in connection with work tickets. Were you present when that work ticket that took you down to Gronigen - were you present at the time it was signed?
