Adjourned for one hour.
Benediction by Moderator.
3. - Met at half-past two zecording to appointment. Prayer by Eld. Snyder. Constitution read by Moderator.
4. - Read the Letters.
5. - Resolved. That Elder Wait be appointed to visit the Church in Murray, and ascertain their state, and their reasons for sending noletters the last two years ;-to report thereon at the next meeting of the Ássociation.
6. - Resolved. That the Report of Elder Hurlbut, in relation to the Church in Clarko, be received; and also a vote of thanks be tendered for his services.
7. - Resolved. That the Delegates from the Grand River and Western Associations, with visiting Brethren, be invited to a seat in this Association.
8. -The Committee of Arrangements reported as follows, viz.: Elder Fulton to preach to-morrow morning at Eleven o'clock; after which he will present the objects and claims of the American Bible Union.

Elder Leach to preach at two o'clock.

9.     - Resolved that the word may, be substituted in place of the word shall, in the 8th article af the Constitution.
