

Municipality: A Bye-Law Relating to Booms and Boomage. Be it ordained by the Municipal Council of A Bye-Law Relating to Dogs. Be it ordained by the Minicipal Conneil of the County of Northumberland :--1 That Farmers and others, being household-ers, residing in the Parish of Newastle, beyond the Police District limits, except those residing between Urquhar's Brook and Russell's Brook, be allowed to keep one dog exempt from dog tax. 2. That any person residing within the County of Northumberland, beyond the dog tax districts of Newastle and Chatham, who owns, keeps, or harbors more than one dog shall pay a tax of \$1.00 annually for each and every dog more than one so owned, harbored, or kept, such tax to be collected as provided by Section 2 of the existing Bre-Law relating to Dogs. 3. That the Collector of dog tax in each Dis-tict or parish be authorized to retain twenty per cent. Ior his services on all sums collected and paid over by him.
