Viscount Uchida Declares Measures Taken To Prevent Detrimental Legislation.

Tokio, March 19:—Japan will stand firmly on her mandate over the island of Yap, in the South Pacific, Viscount Uchida, the foreign minister, declared at a meeting of the budget committee of the Diet yesterday in reply to a member who asked whether the attitude of Great Britain and the council of the League of Nations and that of the United States regarding Yap did not affect Japan's interests, and also whether Japan intended to insist on her rights under the Yap mandate.

Viscount Uchida said the Government was adopting every possible means to prevent the passage of laws similar to those adopted in California.
