Drowned While Skating

Miss Bessie Blair, daughter of Minister of railways and canals and Mr. Henry Harper of the Labor Gazette were drowned in the Ottawa river last Friday while skating. They and four others had been members of a party and had lingered behind.

This party consisted of A. W. Treadgold, mining engineer of Dawson and Miss Amy Blair, who was probably a quarter of a mile in the lead. They came Alex. Creelman, clerk in the Imperial bank here and Miss Bessie Blair, and forty or fifty yards behind them, Mr. Harper and Miss Snowball, daughter of Senator Snowball of Chatham, N. B. The party were coming along gaily. Suddenly the skates of Mr. Creelman and Miss Blair sank in this, soft ice. They were both thrown forward violently and crashed head foremost over a treacherous air hole into the water. Creelman held on to Miss Blair and called out to Harper and Miss Snowball to keep away for God's sake, that they could do more good by keeping away. Harper, however did not wait an instant. He threw off his coat and plunged in to the rescue. Before help arrived they had both sank. The bodies were found on Sunday.

Mr. and Mrs. Blair were at Clifton Springs, N. Y., when the sad accident occurred. It is stated that the telegram sent them was delayed and the first intimation they had of the terrible blow was received through the papers on Saturday morning.
