Is head of the firm of Bryce, McMurrich & Co., Wholesale Merchants, Toronto, Presdt. of the Dominion Telegraph Co., of the Western Assurance Co. of Canada, and of the Commercial Building and Savings' Society, a Vice Presdt. of the Ont. Sabbath School Missionary Union, and a director of the Toronto, Grey & Bruce Railway Co. Has been an Alderman of Toronto. Sat for Saugeen Division in L.C., Can., from 1862 to 1864, when defeated. Was an unsuccessful candidate for same seat in 1856. Returned for present seat at last g. e.—*Toronto.*
