Of the International Bridge Company; praying for an Act to enable them to increase the capital stock of the Company to the sum of three millions of dollars.

Of the Montreal and Champlain Junction Railway Company; praying that the Act 41 Vict., cap. 29, may be so amended as to clearly authorize the Petitioners to take up the existing track between the point of junction of the line of the Petitioners in the said Act mentioned with the line formerly known as the Montreal and Champlain Railway (now the property of the Grand Trunk Company), and Caughnawaga; also, that the Grand Trunk Railway Company may be authorized to abandon that Portion of the line from which the track shall be taken, and be relieved from maintaining the Ferry at Caughnawaga.

Of the Grand Trunk Railway Company; praying that the Potition of the Montreal and Champlain Junction Railway Company may be granted.

Of the Dominion Board of Trade; praying for the extension of the Telegraph System to the Islands in the St. Lawrence.

Of the Canada Life Assurance Company; praying for an Act to amond their Act of Incorporation by providing for an increased proportion of the profits of the Company being allotted to the Assurers upon the Participation Scale; enabling the Directors to fix the time of the Annual General Meeting; removing the restriction as to the number of votes which any one shareholder may cast; granting power to the Company to invest in securities issued in Great Britain or foreign countries, so far as may be necessary for the purpose of carrying on the business of the Company therein, and for other purposes.

Of the President and Directors of the Home Savings' and Loan Company (Limited), of *Toronto*, praying that an Act may be passed to authorize the sale and ransfer to the said Company of the assets and good will of the *Toronto* Savings Bank oy its Trustees, upon such terms as may be mutually agreed upon by the Trustees of the Bank and the Directors of the Company.

Of the Isolated Risk and Farmers' Fire Insurance Company, of Canala, praying for an Act to change the name of the Company to "The Sovereign Fire and Marine Insurance Company of Canada," and to have power to transact the business of Marine Insurance.
