

Montreal and Quebec, crossing the Townships of Wendover or Simpson, in a direct line to Drummondville, including a bridge over the St. Francis, between Wendover and Grantham, thence in a straight line from Drummondville over Grantham and Wickham, until it intersects the road leading to St. Hyacinth, in either of the Townships of Acton or Upton; length of road about forty-one miles:

10 The road from Shipton to Port St. Francis, passing through Kingsey until it intersects the road between the sixth and seventh Ranges of Kingsey, thence between the fifth and sixth ranges of Simpson and Wendover, until it reaches the road down the south-west branch of the River Nicolet, making but slight deviations, as the nature of the ground may require.

20 A new road from the Township of Tring to the Townships of Broughton and Leeds, in the County of Megantic, connecting the various Townships on the Craig's Road with the French Canadian Settlements in the eastern section of the County; the length of road about twenty-seven miles.

25 The opening of a road commencing at the south-west angle of the Seigniorie of Bécancour in the Parish of St. Gregoire, going through the Township of Aston, following the Great Godfrey line to the River Nicolet or at least as far as the 12th Range of Stanfold, from thence turning to the north-east, proceeding through Bulstrode and joining the route which goes through the 10th range of Stanfold, the Quebec Road leading through Arthabaska to the back part of Kingsey as far as Richmond Village in Shipton.
