in any case, to sue out a rule from the principal office at Toronto, for the taxation of costs in such suit by the Master thereat, and thereupon such costs shall be taxed, and final judgment entered at the principal office 5 at Toronto.

II. And whereas in some instances judgments in outer Districts have been held to be irregular, and the same and proceedings thereupon have set aside in consequence of the 10 cognovits upon which the same were entered having been taken in the first instance, and before other proceeding had in the cause: For remedy thereof, be it enacted, That every judgment upon cognovit actionem, 15 chired reguler, heretofore entered by the Deputy Clerk of the Crown in any District of Upper Canada; and regular in other respects, shall be deemed and held to be regular to every intent, whether the cognorit upon which the 20 same was so entered, was given in the first instance or otherwise.
