An Act to incorporate the Congregation of the Most Holv Redeemer.

WHEREAS the persons hereinafter named have, by their Preamble. petition, prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition : Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent 5 of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows :---

2. No legal title deed in which the said community is Redemptorist 15 erroneously designated as "The Redemptorist Fathers" shall Fathers. be set aside by reason of such error, if the said community was intended to be designated by such deed.

2. Only persons belonging to the religious community Who may be known in the Roman Catholic Church under the name of members.

20 "The Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer" may be members of the Congregation.

3. The persons named in section 1 of this Act shall be the First first directors of the Congregation.

2. The board of directors of the Congregation shall consist Number of 25 of five members, of whom three shall be a quorum.
