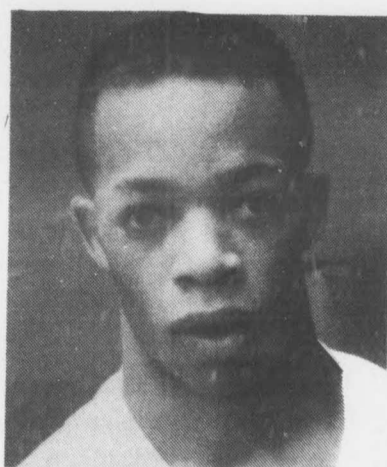

Both Jason and Adam are returning veterans who took a leave of absence last year. Adam has this week's goal clearly outlined, "I'm looking to take out Kenny Drake (of Memorial) to make it to the CI's. That's my number one priority." Coach Ryan credits Jason's work ethic for his success, "Jason is our leader. He's the one ... who the other kids look up to. Come Saturday he should win again, because he's the one who trains

the hardest." Ryan also sees hard work paying off for veteran Darren Anderson, "Darren had a difficult year in trying to make weight classes... but, I think with his experience and his speed that he should be the gold medal match and he'll give the guy a good run for his money."

According to Coach Donnie, The two heavyweight wrestlers will be a devastating force, "Jamie came in to University a couple of years ago at about 158 (lbs). His first year he wrestled 167 (lbs). Last year he wrestled 180 (lbs) and this year he's our heavyweight. With his technique and his speed of a 167-168 pounder and the strength of a

heavyweight he's going to surprise a lot of people come the CIAU's... Sonny has a wounded paw (separated thumb), he's a bear. Whenever someone's injured like that they're irritable and unpredictable and that's the way Sonny's going to be this weekend. He's hungry. It's his last year of University and he wants to go out a champion."

As Jason Pleasant-Sampson put it, "It's a very special thing to be part of a dynasty... All the boys fight knowing that we're the defending champions for the past several years. We're determined to make our reign continue."

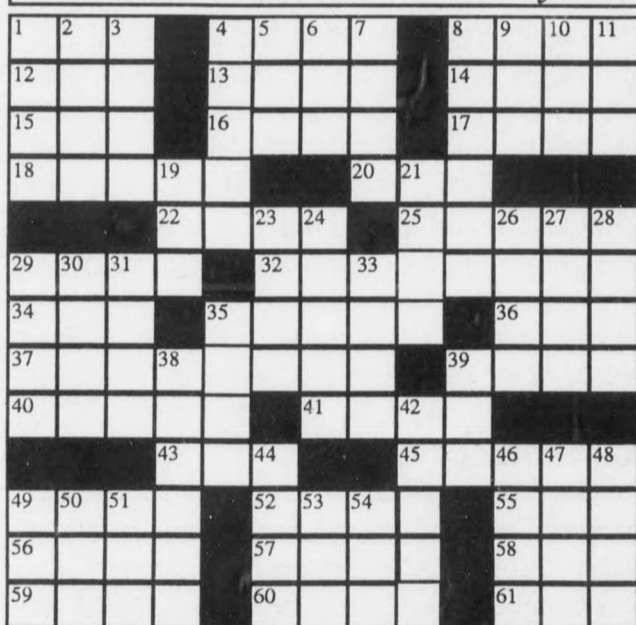

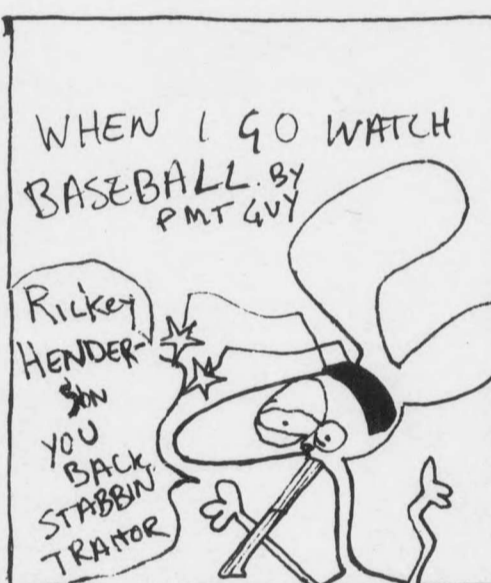

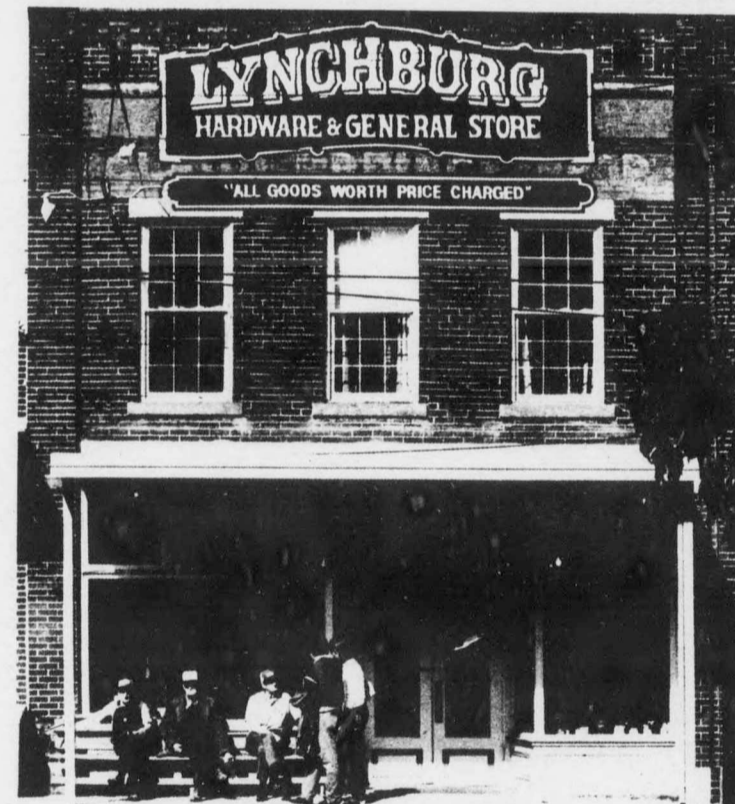
