## Teen charged with break-ins

A Mississauga man arrested near the scene of a break-in in Port Credit has been charged with a further 10 break-ins which occurred on Christmas Day and New Year's Eve.

Police said a witness saw a man break the front window of Denise Cleaners, 382 Lakeshore Rd. W., at 3:50 a.m., Dec. 31 and called them. Police were told by the witness that a suspect had been seen entering an apart-

ment building near the cleaning store.

Police entered the building and arrested Robert McNally, 18, of 370 Lakeshore Rd. W. About \$3.00 in quarters — allegedly taken from the store — has been recovered.

## Bandit robs Miracle Mart

A gunman is believed to have pulled his second holdup in Mississauga within a week. Police said a man wearing blue jeans and a jean jacket walked up to a cashier in the Applewood Plaza Miracle Mart with a bag of groceries Tuesday afternoon and pulled out a black handgun as she

was ringing up the cash register. He demanded money and the woman handed over \$1,400.

The bandit fled from the supermarket as the cashier told the manager what had happened. The manager gave chase, following the gunman into the parking lot. He spotted the man jumping into a station wagon waiting with the motor running at the Sunoco service station at the west end of the plaza. The car sped off.

Police are seeking a short, stocky man in his early twenties, with light-coloured hair. He is also believed to have held up a 17-year-old female cashier at the Save-on Drug Mart at Bloor St. and Dixie Rd. last week. During this armed robbery, the bandit also brandished a black handgun and was wearing a blue denim jacket and jeans.

## Top horticulturalist Minerva Castle dies

Minerva Castle, of Meadowvale, a leading Canadian horticulturalist, died New Year's Day. She was 84.

Miss Castle, who lived at Rowancroft Gardens, her own nursery, was an active member of the Garden Club of Toronto until recent years and in 1969 received its award of honor for horticultural work.

She was awarded the federal government's Centennial medal for Red Cross work and for her contributions to horticulture and also received the award of merit from the Royal Horticultural Society.

"Miss Castle made outstanding contributions nationwide," said Ward 9 councillor Hazel McCallion, who attended the funeral Monday.

"Her passing is a great loss to the Region of Peel and I feel a little part of history has departed," said Mrs. McCallion.

"Even though Miss Castle did not live in Streetsville she made outstanding contributions to this community."

Caye Killaby, councillor for Ward 4 where Miss Castle lived, also attended the funeral services at Trinity Anglican Church in Street-

sville. Interment followed at Mount Pleasant Cemetery in Toronto.

Miss Castle leaves three nephews, John Beck and his wife Margaret, of Meadowvale; Peter With, of Toronto; Bill With and family of Calgary and three nieces, Mrs. Ronald With, of Victoria, B.C.; Mrs. Peggy Purdy and Miss Barbara Roej both of Toronto.
