Q. And you will agree with this, that the only permanent residence of any sort of the Christian Island group of Indians is on the Christian Island. You know what permanent residence means? A. No.

Q. The only houses in which Indian people or anyone else make their homes on those Islands, is on the Christian Island itself? A. Yes.

Q. And any time you saw lumber people or other people taking timber off these Islands---Hope or Beckwith---they were just camping there until they got their timber off? A. Yes.

Q. And the same with the fishing parties you spoke to Mr. Ludwig about? You just came there for a few days? A. Yes.

Q. How old are you Henry? A. 41.

Q. Where were you born? A. On Christian Island.

Q. I suppose you have lived on Christian Island all your life? A. Yes.

Q. What years, can you remember? A. From September, 1915.
