CONFIDENTIAL.

My telegram of June 10th, Imperial Conference Agenda. Up to the present, following the precedent of previous occasions, we have only sent the High Commissioner copies of those memorandums for the Imperial Conference which bear on economic subjects and not those dealing with questions of foreign policy and defences or Inter-Imperial relations.

We think there might be advantage in letting the High Commissioner have the opportunity of seeing other memorandums also, viz; those mentioned in my further telegram of June 10th, but we should not like to communicate these without your Prime Minister's approval.

Will you please show him this telegram and let me know his views.
