NOTE:

After many attempts to obtain a decision, Mr. Cardin, on September 2nd, said he did not care to take part in the Sir John Abbott ceremony at St. Andrews East.

On September 3rd, Mr. Lapointe suggested Mr. Rinfret, who, however, expressed disinclination to act as he considered it an "English-speaking occasion". He suggested Mr. Power.

The matter will again be brought to Mr. Lapointe's attention in about a week's time.
