Ottawa, June 17, 1917.

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 9th instant, in which you speak on behalf of Miss Blackfoot, teacher of the [unclear] school, for permission to allow her to take the summer holidays during the month of July, 1917, and the remainder of the holidays to be taken during the month of January, 1918, and stating the reasons for making this request.

In reply I have to say that the Department will have no objection to Miss Blackfoot taking the holidays during the above named periods. She is, therefore, to re-open this school on the first of August, next, and teach till the end of the year, when she can close the school for the month of January and open it again on the first of February, next. You will be good enough to inform her accordingly.
