



Dear Sir:-

With reference to your letter of September 27th, re the power pole on the Indian Reserve at Nanaimo, owing to the fact that this was consented to by Mr. Christianson, Major MacKay, yourself and the Chief, the matter may for the present be considered as done with authority. You should, however, at the earliest opportunity have the Chief's action confirmed by resolution of the Band and in this way doing what we can to regularize a procedure which strictly speaking is not authorized under the Indian Act.

I would suggest that you should give this matter attention at the first meeting of the Band Council.
