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Provided that the Minister may, with the approval of the Governor in Council, whenever it is deemed necessary or expedient, appoint such other officers, clerks and employees as he shall from time to time determine and fix their remuneration. 5

Powers of
Minister.

4. The Minister may, when authorized by the Governor in Council,
- (a) conduct such national registration and make such survey as may be required for the effective carrying out of *The National Resources Mobilization Act, 1940*; 10
 - (b) Co-operate with other departments and agencies of the government to promote the most efficient development and mobilization of the natural resources and industry and the transportation and publicity services of the nation, for the effective prosecution 15 of the war and the welfare of the country;
 - (c) promote, organize and co-ordinate voluntary assistance with a view to the most effective use of personal services or material contributions for the efficient prosecution of the war and the welfare of the country; and 20
 - (d) co-operate with other departments of the government in making all necessary arrangements with regard to persons taking refuge in or brought to Canada by reason of the present war.

Powers of
Minister.

5. The Minister may perform such other duties as may 25 be assigned to him by the Governor in Council and he shall have all powers necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act and of any orders or regulations made thereunder.

Other organ-
izations.

6. The Minister may establish national, provincial, or local councils, committees or boards and use existing organ- 30 izations and agencies to assist him in carrying out the purposes of this Act.

Expenditures.

7. All expenditures incurred under this Act shall be paid out of the moneys provided by *The War Appropriation Act, 1940*, or otherwise by Parliament for the purposes of 35 this Act.

Orders and
regulations.

8. In addition to the powers otherwise conferred by this Act, the Governor in Council may, from time to time, make such orders or regulations as may be deemed necessary or advisable to carry into effect the purposes of this Act, 40 and any such orders or regulations shall have the same force and effect as if enacted herein.
