In the event of number four being late number eight is to be held in order to ensure of the boys making connection with number eight. stop. You will also arrange with Grand Trunk Western lines to have the train conductor on number four wire whether or not these passengers are on his train. If they do not come forward in train number four car one hundred is not to leave Toronto on number eight but will remain over here until further orders. On receipt of information as to whether or not the passengers are on number four you will please arrange for advice to be given to Mr Nichol who will be on car number one hundred and in touch with the Prime Minister.
