supply of good milk. Patients under weight or far advanced in the disease get special diets. The Sanatorium is fortunate in having a good milk supply from tuberculin-tested cows.

### Medical Care and Nursing.

A Medical Superintendent is in charge of the institution, assisted by a staff of nurses. The routine is thorough
