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"1. <i>Resolved</i> —That the accounts of expenditure for salaries and contingencies of the Senate, and for their members' indemnity, should be audited by the Auditor-General, in the same manner as those of the House of Commons may hereafter be.	
"2. <i>Resolved</i> —That the amounts of payment made under the authority of all Joint Committees of both Houses should be audited by the Auditor-General.	
"3. <i>Resolved</i> —That a message be sent to the Commons, acquainting that House that the Senate hath passed the foregoing Resolutions, and will give effect to them on their part."—Sir Alex. Campbell.	157
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
