## OHIO AFTER THEM

State Prosecutor Moves Against Two Big Insurance Companies.

Akron, Ohio, Oct. 28.—Two warrants proceedings were commenced in the circuit court here on Saturday afternoon by Prosecuting Attorney Hargrave against the Mutual Life Insurance Company and the New York Life Insurance Company, to oust them from the state by taking their franchise from them, on the ground that the companies have misused their powers for the past five years in violation of the laws of the state. Thirty-three interrogatories are submitted to the companies to be answered.

The appointment of receivers is asked for.
